

Statement of Evidence:

East Quarter of Section 5, Township 38 North, Range 31 West, East Langola Township,
4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

10" Blk Oak	S 40 W	693 links
10" Bur Oak	S 44 E	1295 links

1931 County Engineer's notebook No. 64 contains road survey for CR "A" (21) by H. G. Elletson. Survey notes show same information as in County Surveyor's Record Book 2, page 92, which notes a hub with the following reference ties:

Fence Post	E	47.5'
2" Poplar	SE	48.0'

Stationing gives distances of 2659.0 feet to the SE corner and 2761.0 feet to the NE corner with a deflection angle of 0-21' left (running north to south).

1957 County Engineer's Notebook No. 206 contains a survey for CSAH No. 21 running south to north on the section line. Corner is shown as a spike set in center of road with field entrance east. Ties;

7" Pop	SE	50.3
PP	NE	50.05

Stationing gives distances of 2658.95 feet to the SE corner and 2761.0 feet to the NE corner with a deflection angle of 0-20' left (running north to south).
