

Statement of Evidence:

H053

East Quarter Corner of Section 5, Township 37 North, Range 29 West, Gilmanton Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked with a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

9" Sugar	S 85 1/2 E	15 links
10" Sugar	N 63 1/2 W	49 links

1885 Surveyor's report by Felix Parrant, County Surveyor, shows corner found and $\frac{1}{4}$ line run east 79.40 chains to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 4.

1997 William Lunser, LS 9394, set a CIM by lost position with a distance of 2687.70 feet to the SE corner and 2754.89 feet to the NE corner. He filed a Certificate of Location (Doc. No. 283112).

2003 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2009 The Benton County Surveyor's Office reset the CIM by lost methods after locating the northeast corner of Section 5. The CIM was adjusted 2.1 feet. This position fits the 1885 distance east to the east quarter of Section 4 within 7 feet. The CIM falls in a farm field.
