

Statement of Evidence:

North Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 38 North, Range 30 West, Graham Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Original US General Land Office set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded:

6" Poplar	S 44 E	22 links
6" Poplar	N 3 E	15 links

A 10" Poplar was noted as a line tree, East 22.10 chains.

1914 Phil Randall, Morrison County Surveyor, notes in Surveyor Record Book A, page 165, (Morrison County) a survey of Section 36, 39-30. He set stake at the corner location by lost method, midway and on line, measuring 5366 feet between found section corners.

1990 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, dug in area of a fence corner for Randall's stake and found no evidence of a corner marker. He accepted the fence corner as evidence of the obliterated corner and set a cast iron monument. He filed a Certificate of Location (#199553) and notes a distance of 2679.23 feet to the NW corner Sec 1 and a distance of 2668.51 feet to the NE corner Sec 1.

2002 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.
Note: Wellen's corner is 5.4 feet east of the lost position.
