

Statement of Evidence:

C082

Northeast Quarter Corner of Section 8, Township 38 North, Range 30 West, Graham Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1852 Original US General Land Office survey established this corner and set a wood post in a mound for the corner location with a pit 8 links south.
- 1923 County Engineer's Notebook No. 40 contains a survey for CAR No. 1 running south to north. Notes show corner with ties:

- 1964 County Engineer's Notebook No. 276 contains a road survey for CSAH No. 22 running west to east on section line. Notes show corner marked by a nail set in center of road. Ties:

- 1984 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a 3/4" X 24" Boat Spike at the centerline of an east/west road and 13.1 feet west of the north/south centerline. He replaced the found iron with a cast iron monument and filed a Certificate of Location (#173406).
- 2008 Westwood Professional Services found a CIM fitting 1984 Wellen and 1964/1969 County ties. CIM is accepted as marking the obliterated position for this corner. County Coordinates obtained by GPS
