

**Statement of Evidence:**

**C192**

Northeast Corner of Section 19, Township 38 North, Range 30 West, Graham Township,  
4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1852 Original US General Land Office survey established this corner and set a wood post and bearing trees were recorded.

4" Blk Oak	S 72 1/2 W	53 links
4" Blk Oak	N 29 E	113 links

- 1914 County Road Book, page 120 contains a road survey by M. J. Cleveland, District Engineer, for State Road No. 7. Survey shows corner found and road run east-west from the corner with tie: T.P. S 48 W 40 feet.

- 1931 County Engineer's Notebook No. 81 for survey of SAR 12 running east to west. Corner is shown as a spike with town road north. Ties:

Cor. F.P.	NW	43.7'
Cor F.P.	NE	38.6'

- 1959 County Engineer's Notebook No. 220 contains a road survey for CSAH 12 running west to east on section line. Corner is shown marked by a spike set in center of road with town road north and south. 1963 ties are the same as below to small iron.

- 1963 County Surveyor's Record Book 2, page 194 notes an iron with the following reference ties:

PP	SW	85.9
PP	SE	57.9
TP	NE	53.5
16" Boxelder	SW	61.9

Older ties to spike same as shown in 1931.

- 1983 Paul Wellen's, LS 10461, notes show found nail at corner and measured 2765.63 feet to the East 1/4 corner of Section 18.

- 1987 Paul Wellen, set a cast iron monument at the centerline of a road north/south and east/west. He filed a Certificate of Location (#182949).

- 1992 Bruce Shepperd, LS 17003, with MN/DNR, found a cast iron monument at the centerline of roads north/south and east/west. He filed a Certificate of Location (#12984). He notes a distance of 2764.14 feet to the East 1/4 corner Sec 18 and a distance of 2678.72 feet to the North 1/4 corner Sec 20 and accepted the CIM as marking the obliterated corner position.
