

Statement of Evidence:

Meander Corner No. 15 on the North Line of Section 2, Township 37 North, Range 31 West, Watab Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey established the corner and set a wood post and bearing trees recorded:
- 8" Bur Oak S 70 E 950 links
- This corner is 14.90 chains west of the NE Corner of Section 2.
- 2002 On 9/11/02 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a 1½ " iron pipe 138.22 feet west of the Northeast corner of Section 2. Little Rock Lake is significantly larger than during the original GLO survey because of the dam on the Mississippi River. The corner now falls in the lake. Accepted the found iron pipe as being evidence of the north line of Section 2 and established the Meander Corner position by single proportion measurement between the Northeast corner of Section 2 and the North Quarter corner of Section 3 and on the extension of the line from the Northeast corner of Section 2 through the found iron pipe. Measured 7992.49 feet, putting the Meander Corner at 992.40 feet (15.04 chains) west of the Northeast corner of Section 2.
