

**Statement of Evidence:**

**F21H**

Meander Corner No. 8 on the North Line of Section 21, Township 37 North, Range 31 West, Watab Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1850 Original US General Land office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.  
12" Boxelder S 56 E 26 links  
12" W. Elm N 10 E 130 links  
This corner is 39.30 chains west of the NE corner of Sec. 21.

1952 County Highway Notebook 1, page 7, contains a survey by J.D. Kotsmith of the north line of Section 21 lying west of the County road. Survey shows an iron pipe set on east-west fence line 48 feet east of the Mississippi River and that a wood hub was found east of this point as set by Elletson in a previous survey.

1977 William Lunser, LS 9394, found a 3/4" pipe and left it as is and filed a Certificate of Location (#147072). He notes a distance of 1658.59 feet to the NE Corner of Sec. 21.

1995 Comstock and Davis performed GPS work under contract with Benton County and Coordinates Obtained by GPS NAD 83 (1986 Adjustment) to a 1/2 " iron pipe:  
N- 148134.629  
E – 461148.225

2003 Surveying & Engineering Professionals, Inc reported finding a 3/4 " iron pipe 1658.44 feet west of the NE corner.
