

Statement of Evidence:

F27J

Meander Corner No. 10 on the North Line of Section 27, Township 37 North, Range 31 West, Watab Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1850 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

10" Bur Oak S 77 1/2 E 202 links

6" Bur Oak N 83 E 218 links

This corner is 28.80 chains west from the NE corner of Section 27.

NOTE: In the early 1900's the Sartell dam was built, which flooded the corner area.

1961-1968 County Highway notes show the following reference ties.

10" Oak ENE 66.7'

PP ESE 61.0'

1978 Ronald Engelmeyer, LS #13334, found a flat iron 1696.38 feet (25.70 chains) west of the Northeast corner of Section 27 (Shown on Certificate of Location for the NE corner of Sec. 27, Doc. No. 151563) with the following reference ties:

SE Corner Blk. Foundation N 44.47

SW Corner Blk. Foundation NW 63.07

6" Oak SW 49.50

2003 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a cast iron monument (CIM), 1696.45 feet west of the NE corner of Section 27. The CIM does not represent the government meander corner, but is accepted as a reference monument marking the north line of Section 27.
