

**Statement of Evidence:**

**F361**

North Quarter Corner of Section 36, Township 37 North, Range 31 West, Watab Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1850 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

- 1982 On July 15, 1982 William Lunser, LS 9394, found a 1/2" iron pipe and replaced it with a cast iron monument and filed a Certificate of Location (#173437). He notes a distance of 2660.29 feet to the NW Corner of Section 36.
- 2003 Surveying & Engineering Professionals found a CIM. They measured 2654.97 feet to the NE corner and 2660.44 feet to the NW corner of Section 36. Corner is 6.7 feet south 2.9 feet east of the lost position.
- 2004 County Coordinates obtained by GPS to CIM.

- 2008 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a cast iron monument at the intersection of fence lines north and west and a tree line east. Measured 2660.41 feet to the NW corner and 2655.00 feet to the NE corner of Section 36 which agrees with 1982 Lunser and 2003 Surveying & Engineering Professionals distances. CIM is accepted as marking the obliterated position for this corner. Coordinates obtained by GPS coincide with 2004 position.
