

Statement of Evidence:

F112

Northeast Corner of Section 11, Township 37 North, Range 31 West, Watab Township,
4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1850 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

14" Bur Oak	S 73 E	245 links
6" Bur Oak	N 19 W	28 links

1923 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 333, shows a survey of Section 1 by Samuel S. Chute, which notes an iron monument at the corner location with the following reference tie:

Double Oak	SE	132 feet
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He measured 2674.84 feet to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 2 (well point) and 2760.94 to North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 12 (post).

No Date: County notes show iron pipe at the corner with the following reference ties.

24" Bur Oak	SE	131.1
14" Bur Oak	N	158.7
PP	NE	36.15

1961-1968 M.W.Carley, LS 855, notes the following reference ties:

PP	NE	36.44
FP	W	39.8
FP	SW	37.44

1978 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a 1/2" iron pipe on the centerline of a township road east and north. He filed a Certificate of Location (#151861).

1982 Paul Wellen's notes show a distance of 2763.79 feet to the North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 12 and 2642.77 feet to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 11.

2005 Daniel Kron, LS 42621, found 1 1/2" iron pipe and measured 2661.97 feet to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 2 and 2764.82 feet to the North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 12. Distances seem to confirm that the iron found is the same as set in the 1923 survey.
