

**Statement of Evidence:**

**E011**

The North Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 38 North, Range 32 West, West Langola Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Original US General Land Office surveyor, Theodore Conkey, set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

4" Blk Oak                      S 42 1/2 W                      244 links

2" Blk Oak                      N 76 1/4 E                      437 links

A line tree is noted 12" Bur Oak, West 24.34 chains

1979 Carley Engineering established this corner and set a 1/2" iron pipe at the corner location, while doing a subdivision of Section 36-39-32.

1982 David Regan, LS 12236, found a 1/2" iron pipe and set a cast iron monument in its place. He found no resurvey information in the Benton or Morrison County records on this corner. He replaced the iron pipe with a County cast iron monument.

1988 On July 14, 1988 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a cast iron monument and filed a Certificate of Location (#191233).

2002 On June 5, 2002 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a broken off cast iron monument. We measured 5433.61 feet between section corners and found the 1/4 corner to be 18.77 feet east of the lost position.
