

**Statement of Evidence:**

**E042**

The Northeast Corner of Section 4, Township 38 North, Range 32 West, West Langola Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey established this corner and set a wood post for the corner location with the following bearing trees marked:

- 1986 Document No. 308438 in Morrison County is a Certificate of Location for this corner by Thomas Thiesen, LS 16097, showing the corner re-established by obliterated means after excavating and finding no evidence of the corner. A cast iron monument was set.
- 1995 Comstock and Davis performed GPS work under contract with Benton County and Coordinates Obtained by GPS NAD 83 (1986 Adjustment) to a CIM:

- 2002 On June 6, 2002 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a 1/2" iron with an unknown cap number at the centerline of a north/south road and +/- 20 feet north of a power pole line. We found 2 ties from the 1986 certificate that fit the iron found.
- 2006 Neither the original government corner post nor bearing or line trees were found. Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a 1/2" iron pipe capped 22072 in the centerline of the north-south road and 20 feet north of a power line. This corner location fits the original GLO distance west within 4 feet assuming two 2-pole busts and within a half foot to the east again assuming two 2-pole busts. Several half-miles along the north County line measure approximately 33 or 66 feet (2 or 4 poles) long of 2640. I accepted the 1/2" iron pipe as marking the obliterated position and obtained updated coordinates.
