

**Statement of Evidence:**

**E031**

The North Quarter Corner of Section 3, Township 38 North, Range 32 West, West Langola Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office surveyor, Theodore Conkey, set a wood post in a mound with a pit 6 links east for the corner location.
- 1879 County Surveyor's Record Book 2, page 1, contains a road survey by Richard Cronk that shows road from the south terminating at this corner.
- 2002 On June 6, 2002 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. searched for monument and found barbed wire lying down, but dug no further.
- 2006 At this location neither the original GLO corner post nor pit and mound were found. Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a ½" iron pipe capped 22702 at the single-proportionate measurement location approximately 8 feet north of a east-west power line. This corner location fits the original GLO distance east and west within a half foot assuming two 2-pole busts. Several half-miles along the north County line measure approximately 33 or 66 feet (2 or 4 poles) long of 2640. I accepted the ½" iron pipe as marking the lost position and obtained updated coordinates.
