

**Statement of Evidence:**

**K022**

The Northeast Corner of Section 2, Township 36 North, Range 29 West, St. George Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Original General Land Office survey established this corner set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

1986 William Lunser, LS 9394, set a cast iron monument at the centerline of a road east/west and a fence line north. This location checks with measurements to the corners to the east and west. He filed a Certificate of Location (#191238) and notes a distance of 2656.00 feet to the North ¼ Corner Sec 2 and a distance of 2356.37 feet to the East ¼ Corner Sec 2.

2009 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. excavated with a Benton County backhoe. A 20-foot east-west by 9-foot north-south by 5-foot deep hole was dug to below original soil. No additional evidence of the corner location was found. A 3/8-inch by 15-inch rebar capped 19552 was set in place of the found CIM, reference ties were established and the 2003 coordinates were verified.
