

Statement of Evidence:

K111

The North Quarter Corner of Section 11, Township 36 North, Range 29 West, St. George Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1855 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

- 1898 County Road Book, page 141, shows road surveyed by Felix Parrent, County Surveyor, south and north from this corner.
- 1907 County Road Book, pages 2 and 3 contains a road survey by Felix Parent, County Surveyor, where road ran north-south on quarter line. Notes state: drove gas pipe 1 1/4 " x 16" at corner.
- 1950 Minnesota Highway Department found a 6" granite monument and left it as is. They set 3 iron pins as reference monuments and filed a Certificate of Location. Alignment map for TH 25 shows corner 12.0 feet west of PI.
- 1997 Bogart and Pederson set a RR spike with punch mark using T.H. No. 25 R/W monuments and alignment map information. They did not dig for the stone and did not find any evidence of the 3 iron pin reference monuments. They prepared a Statement of Evidence and a draft Certificate of Location.
- 2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a RR spike and replaced it with a cast iron monument. They did not dig for the stone.
