

Statement of Evidence:

K133

East Quarter Corner of Section 13, Township 36 North, Range 29 West, St. George Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees:

8" W Oak	S 88 E	62 links
12" W Oak	N 10 W	57 links

A line tree was noted as a 12" Blk Oak North 15.41 chains.

2002 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2005 WSN searched corner area and could find no evidence of a corner marker. Set a spike for approximate corner at intersection of fence lines south and east. Measured 2662.28 feet north to the NE corner and 2632.23 feet south to the SE corner and found the spike to be 47.30 feet east of a straight line between section corners. The lost position would be 14.5 feet north and 47.5 feet west of the spike, which would fall in field. The fence lines appear to be the only evidence of the corner's obliterated position and replaced the spike with a cast iron monument.
