

**Statement of Evidence:**

**K362**

Northeast Corner of Section 36, Township 36 North, Range 29 West, St. George Township, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post with bearing trees noted as:  
10" Bur Oak S 17 1/2 E 1181 links  
8" Bur Oak N 56 E 491 links  
A line tree was noted as a 6" Bur Oak South 16.95 chains.
- 1916 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, pages 67 to 69, and Record Book A, Map No. 29, contains a survey of Section 31, 36-28 by J. P. Soderstrum. He states he located corner in center of north-south road from GLO BT to the SE – S 17 ½ E 1188 links and planted a 5" x 5 " x 24 " granite stone for the corner.
- 1922 Bradley Engineering Services did a survey to establish the north-south ¼ line of Section 31 filed in Plat Cabinet D, 95B. The survey shows stone used for the corner.
- 1940 County Engineer's Notebook No. 134 contains survey of CAR 40 running south to north on township line. Corner is shown as a granite monument. Ties:  
FP E 21.90  
FP SE 51.75
- 1964 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 155 contains ties to a granite monument:  
TP SE 50.8  
PP NW 72.5  
Other ties (No Date):  
FP East 25.9  
FP West 32.5  
(County Engineer's Notebook No. 134 shows hub set over granite monument with same ties.)
- 1983 David Regan, LS 12236, found a 5 ½ " x 5 ½ " granite stone monument in center line of north-south road. He set a ½ " iron pipe over the stone monument and filed a Certificate of Location (Doc. No. 166041).
- 2005 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found 1" iron pipe in center of north-south road.
- 2008 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a ½" open iron pipe in the center of a north-south bituminous road (Benton Co. Rd 49). Found a PP tie which checks with Regan's 1983 tie when he found the Soderstrum stone from 1916. The Surveyor accepts the position and set additional ties.
