

Statement of Evidence:

M011

North Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 36 North, Range 31 West, Sauk Rapids
Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

- 1849 Original US General Land Office survey established this corner and set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

- Notes show corner at the edge of a brook. Line trees were noted as a 12" Poplar East 11.1 chains and a 4" Blk Oak West 22.62 chains.
- 1990 Paul E Wellen, LS 10461, found a 3/4" iron pipe near fence lines running east, south, and west. He set a cast iron monument over the 3/4" iron pipe and filed a Certificate of Location (#201564). The cast iron monument is 0.25 feet east of the fence corner. He measured 2676.34 feet to the NW corner and 2684.32 feet to the NE corner of Section 1.
- 2002 No resurvey information found on this corner in the Benton County records.
- 2004 Found CIM and measured 2676.21 feet to the NW corner and 2684.42 feet to the NE corner.

- 2011 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found the Cast Iron Monument (CIM) at the intersection of fences east-west and south and 225 feet west of a fence to the north. The CIM fits a split of distances between section corners within 4 feet and has been the accepted position since 1990. The 2004 coordinates were verified and reference ties established.
