

**Statement of Evidence:**

**G133**

East Quarter Corner of Section 13, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Corner established by Original US General Land Office survey and marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as.

6" Ironwood	S 22 E	27 links
18" W Oak	N 54 W	39 links

Line trees were noted as a 18" Elm, South, 19.80 chains and a 6" Poplar, North, 19.63 chains.

1994 David Regan, LS 12236, found a 1/2" iron pin on the centerline of road north/south and a fence line west and +/- 28 feet south of a field line east. He filed a Certificate of Location (#231243).

2008 Westwood Professional Services found a 1/2" iron pin on the centerline of road north/south, 8 feet south of a fence line west and +/- 29 feet south of a fence line east. The found pin fits occupation lines at the sixteenth north within a foot and south within 3 feet and fits a split of the distances between section corners within 3.5 feet. The iron pin is accepted as marking the obliterated corner position.

2010 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found the 1/2" iron pin 0.3 feet below the road surface, established references as shown and verified the 2008 coordinates.
