

**Statement of Evidence:**

**G243**

East Quarter Corner of Section 24, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Corner established by Original US General Land Office survey and marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as.

10" Elm          N 28 E          11 links

12" Elm          S 59 W          12 links

Line trees were noted as a 8" W Birch, South, 19.32 chains and a 6" Poplar, North, 20.45 chains.

2002 No record evidence of this corner has been found in the Benton County records.

2010 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a 1/2" iron pipe capped RLS 23044 at the lost position falling on the extension of a fence west and 78 feet east of a fence north, measuring 2676.77 feet to the section corners north and south. The fence north looks to be a fence of convenience, not a line fence. With no other evidence to consider the found iron is accepted as marking the corner position. GPS coordinates were obtained.
