

**Statement of Evidence:**

**G131**

North Quarter Corner of Section 13, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

24" W Elm	N 52 E	25 links
10" Aspen	S 20 W	12 links

1899 Road Survey Report by John E. Whilt, County Surveyor, shows survey running west to east on section line with a distance of 79.72 chains for the north line of Sec. 13, with no mention of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner.

2008 Westwood Professional Services found a 1/2" iron pipe in the east-west centerline of a gravel road and on a long standing occupation line south. The iron falls 6 feet north and 6.5 feet east of the lost position. The iron pipe is accepted as marking the obliterated corner position.
