

**Statement of Evidence:**

**G181**

North Quarter Corner of Section 18, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as.

8" Blk Oak	S 14 E	232 links
6" Blk Oak	S 9 W	333 links

1979 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, set a cast iron monument at a fence line south/west. He filed a Certificate of Location (#154386) and notes a distance of 2630.489 feet to the center of Sec 18.

2008 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a cast iron monument at a fence line south/west. The distance west measures 106 feet long of GLO and the distance east 82 feet long of GLO. It is not unusual for distances to vary 100 feet or more from GLO on the closing distances along the north and west tier of the townships in Benton County. The occupation lines are well established and the CIM is accepted as marking the obliterated corner position. Coordinates were obtained from a side tie from two points set by GPS. Reference ties were established.
