

**Statement of Evidence:**

North Quarter Corner of Section 21, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

8" Aspen	S 54 W	104 links
6" Aspen	N 25 W	400 links

1939 County Engineer's Notebook No. 158 contains road survey for CAR No. 20 running east to west along the section line. No corner is shown and stationing gives distance of 5311.8 feet for the north line of Section 21.

2012 The Benton County Surveyor's Office searched for a corner monument with a metal locator but no evidence was found. Field surrounds the corner position in all four quadrants with a gravel drive to the south being located on the east side of the corner position. The lost position appears to align with the drive south, fits the centerline intersection at the west sixteenth within 2 feet and appears to be the historical position for the corner. A 1/2" x 18" iron pipe capped 19552 was set to mark the lost position.
