

Statement of Evidence:

G092

Northeast Corner of Section 9, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4th Principal Meridian, (Mayhew Lake Township) Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office surveyor, Edwin James, established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as.

10" Aspen	N 51 1/2 W	171 links
4" Bur Oak	N 47 1/2 E	39 links

2002 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe with cap marked BWK 10918 on west shoulder of road. Iron is in line with road centerline south, and fences east and west. Fence line north is approximately 12 feet east and road east is approximately 15 feet north.

There are large oak trees and stumps in the area, but none NE of the found iron.

No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2003 Survey by Sidney Williamson, LS 10918, shows capped iron pipe set for corner with distances of 2665.21 to the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner and 2666.97 to the North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 9.
