

Statement of Evidence:

G152

Northeast Corner of Section 15, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4th Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as:

13" Bur Oak	S 82 1/4 E	22 links
10" Blk Oak	S 36 W	4 links

1899 Road Survey Report by John E. Whilt, County Surveyor, shows survey running west to east on section lines.

1938 County Engineer's Notebook No. 122 contains a road survey for CAR 24 running north to south. Notes show corner marked by a hub set in intersection of roads north-south and west. Ties:

12" Oak	NW	51.4
TP	NE	36.6

1971 County Engineer's Notebook No. 122 contains a notation that spike was placed with ties:

PP	SW	58.55'
2 nd FP	SE	55.3'

1990 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, set a cast iron monument at the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 59 (running north and south) and 95th Street NE (running east and west). He filed a Certificate of Location (#201456).

2006 Westwood Professional Services Inc. excavated a 10-foot by 10-foot by 4-foot deep hole with a Benton County backhoe. No additional evidence was found. A 1/2" iron pipe capped 19552 was set at centerline of roads north/south/east/west in place of the found CIM.
