

**Statement of Evidence:**

**G262**

The Northeast Corner of Section 26, Township 37 North, Range 30 West, 4<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Mayhew Lake Township, Benton County, Minnesota.

1852 Original US General Land Office survey established corner marked by a wood post with bearing trees noted as.

6" Aspen	N 69 W	6 links
7" Aspen	S 56 E	6 links

1890 County Road Book, page 32, contains Surveyor's Report by Felix Parrent stating road laid out on section lines west and north from this corner.

1941 County Engineer's Notebook No. 150 contains a road survey for CAR 25 running south to north on section line. Corner is shown marked by a hub set in center of road with town road west. Ties same as below in 1949.

1944 County Engineer's Notebook No. 164 contains a road survey for CAR 25 running south to north on section line. Corner is shown marked by a hub set in center of road with town road west. Ties same as below in 1949.

1949 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 431: Elletson notes a hub with the following reference ties:

FP	SW	46.4
FP	SW	50.5

1969 County Engineer's Notebook No. 288 contains a road survey for CSAH No. 25 running south to north on section line. Corner is shown marked by a spike set in center of road with town road west. Notation in 1975 states placed iron with same ties as below.

1975 County Surveyor's Record Book 1, page 433, notes an iron with the following reference ties:

FP	SW	49.4
PP	NW	58.4

1990 Paul Wellen, LS 10461, found a 1" solid pin at the intersection of the centerline of County Road 25 (running north and south) and 75<sup>th</sup> Street NE (running west) and a field line (from the east). He set a cast iron monument over the iron and filed a Certificate of Location (#200722). He noted above reference ties were gone.

1999 Doc No. 283107 notes a distance of 2691.18 feet to the East 1/4 corner Sec 23.

2009 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a cast iron monument 0.4 feet below the road surface. The monument measures within 1.6 feet of the 1941 and 0.6 feet of the 1999 distance a half mile north and within 1.2 feet of the 1941 distance a half mile south. The cast iron monument is accepted as the best available evidence of the corner location.
