

Statement of Evidence:

I243

East Quarter Corner of Section 24, Township 37 North, Range 28 West, Maywood Township, 4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1849 Original US General Land Office survey set a wood post at this location and bearing trees were recorded.

10" Tamarack S 6 ½ W 418 links

12" Tamarack N 51 W 190 links

Line trees were noted as a 4" Blk Ash South 21.10 chains and
a 22" Pine North 22.12 chains.

1996 John Oliver, LS 8194, Mille Lacs County Surveyor, set corner by lost method (north-south) and held center of north-south road (east-west) and filed Certificate of Location (No. 244628)

2002 No resurvey information was found on this corner in the Benton County records.

2008 The County Surveyor's Office searched and found no monument but did find ties to the same as documented in Oliver's Certificate of Location (Mille Lacs County No. 244628). The Surveyor re-set the monument, which falls in line with a field line to the west and on centerline with a north-south road (195th Ave NE). Distances to the NE Cor. and SE Cor. measure 2634.98 ft. and 2635.06 ft., respectively, and the corner falls on a straight line between said corners, thus confirming Oliver's lost method. The Surveyor accepts Oliver's position and recorded ties.
