

Statement of Evidence:

I092

Northeast Corner of Section 9, Township 37 North, Range 28 West, Maywood Township,
4th Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

1855 Original US General Land Office survey established this corner and set a wood post for the corner and bearing trees were recorded.

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| 12" Br. Oak | N 73 W | 7 links |
| 10" Br. Oak | S 59 W | 11 links |

1901 County Road Book, pages 206 and 266, shows road surveyed by John Whilt, County Surveyor, running north and west from this corner.

1915 County Surveyors Records Book 2, pages 314 and 315, and Record Book A, Map No. 9, shows J. P. Soderstrum did a survey of Section 3. The survey shows he found the stumps of 2 BT's with marks plain and shows stake set.

1923 County Engineer's notebook No. 33 for SR No. 7 running north-south shows a stone at the corner with stake 2 feet under. County Surveyor's Record Book 2, page 402, notes call for a stake and a stone at the corner with the same ties:

2001 Westwood Professional Services, Inc. found a PK at the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 7 (running north and south) and 105th Street NE (running west). Removed the PK and set a cast iron monument at the location and established reference ties.

2005 On 4/20/05 excavated corner area with Benton County Highway Dept. backhoe. Dug down 4 feet and found no evidence of the stone referred to in 1923. Soil appearance indicated that road could have been sub-cut in this area. Accepted previous set CIM position as the best evidence of the obliterated corner location.

2012 The Benton County Surveyor's Office found a PK Nail and replaced it with a 1/2" by 14" iron pipe capped 19552 at the accepted obliterated corner position. The 2002 coordinates were verified.
