

In the Matter of the Petition
of John P. Goedert and Others

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Benton

State of Minnesota:

The undersigned viewers, appointed by your order bearing date the 23rd day of February, 1905, to view the route proposed in the petition of John P. Goedert, and others for a public ditch or drain and branch ditch

would respectfully report that we met at the time and place specified in your said order, preparatory to commencing our duties as such viewers, and provided with the civil engineer appointed to have charge of said matter, and did view and examine the said public's ditch from its source to its outlet, and the lands over which the same passes, and the lands adjacent thereto to be affected thereby. We did estimate the benefits and damages to lands affected by said public's ditch. And we did cause to be prepared, in tabular form, a statement showing the names of the owners of each tract of land to be benefited or damaged by the construction of said public's ditch, the description of each tract benefited or damaged (said names of owners and descriptions being the same as appear on the County tax duplicates of said Benton County), and the total number of acres in each of said tracts, the estimated number of acres in each of said tracts of land to be benefited or damaged (as the case may be), and the amount that each tract of land will be benefited or damaged by the construction of said work, which said statement is hereby made a part of this report and attached hereto, marked Exhibit 1 of Viewers Report

And (in case said ditch drains, either in whole or in part, any public or corporate road or railroad, or benefits any of said roads) we did estimate the benefits arising therefrom to all roads and railroads adjacent thereto.

and did report said benefits, names of roads, and amounts of benefits to each in a tabulated statement hereto attached, marked Exhibit 2

And we do hereby report the total estimated benefits of said Public Ditch to be \$8134.50 and the total estimated cost and expense of construction of said Public Ditch including the damages awarded therefor, to be \$3441.41 and that the utility of said proposed Public Ditch is greater than the estimated expense of the construction of such Public Ditch
